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PREFACE

Kahonri is a Thammazite language sharing common ancestry with Cospian, Narsadese, and Dagaithi. An ancient language by human standards, Kahonri is the tongue of the Kaphrimoth, an ancient book of scripture, and most Incarnandist scripture. The modern language is spoken in Jerushabla and Oliblish and by Incarnandist scholars throughout the world.

Kahonri as a constructed language is heavily inspired by Hebrew and Arabic.
